


How The Scoring App Works?


1.0 Introduction

To start the App, select the **LET Advanced Scoring & Stats** icon located on the Home Screen. After launching the app, you will be directed to the app's start screen.




2.0 Scoring Set Up

Select Ladies European Tour then the Tournament to begin scoring.




2.1 Select the Round Number






2.2 Select Personal Scorer



2.3 Select Next.






2.4 Select Match Number



2.5 Select All Players






3.0 Start Scoring

When the scorer collects their equipment, the below screen will be displayed. The volunteer will need to enter the scores for **all the players** as they finish each hole. Then the volunteer needs to select **submit and confirm** then it will take them to the next hole.











3.1 Each volunteer will receive a scorecard and a pen or pencil so they can tally each players score for each hole. Once each player completes the hole, the volunteer can input the scores into the mobile phone device.



3.2 Lock your phone in between shots to save battery. This can be done by tapping the **power on/off button** as shown below. To unlock the phone, tap the same button.





4.0 Editing Scores

If you accidentally input the wrong score the volunteer **will not** be able to go back to the previous hole to amend this. Instead, they will need to radio through to score control, stating the match number, players name and the score that needs to be amended.

For example:

Scorer: "Match 1 to score control"

Score Control: "Go Ahead Match 1"

Scorer: "Player 1 W. Hillier was a 5 on hole 5 not a 4"

ETIQUETTE

Each scorer will be allocated a group where they will be responsible for counting and inputting the scores for each player. Scorers should keep adequate distance away from players so they do not interfere with their stroke or line of vision. Additionally, when transmitting radio communications please be aware of any players within close proximity.

RADIOS

Every scorer will be issued a radio and an earpiece along with their scoring device. If a hole is finished but the scores have not been received, a member of staff at score control will radio the scorer to collect the scores for that hole. Therefore, it is imperative that all scorers keep their earpiece in at all times whilst on the golf course, this will also reduce the noise on the course.

REFEREES

If a player asks for a referee, radio score control with your match number and wait for a reply. Then provide the hole number and exact location of where the referee is needed. For example, "Referee needed on the right-hand side of the fairway on hole 11 about 100 yards short of the green". The scorer must wait for a reply from score control to ensure the message has been received and actioned.

BATTERY LIFE

Score Control can monitor your phones battery life remotely and will send out a replacement if needed. You can also use your radio to call in and request a new device. If your phone does turn off, we may ask you to radio through the scores whilst we get you a replacement phone.
